What has grace accomplished in me?

⁹ For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. ¹⁰ But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. 1 Corinthians 15

The apostle Paul was overwhelmed by the grace of God. The sense of being overwhelmed seems to be greater when the sin we are delivered from is greater. Paul's sin was great, and so that accomplishment of grace felt, and was huge for Paul. So much so that he even got a name change! From Saul to Paul.

Matthew, the disciple who wrote the Gospel of Matthew, no doubt felt something very similar. He wrote about himself and his story in Matthew 9. He was a tax collector. Along with that job title he adds the synonym "sinner." Tax collectors were considered lowly thieving beasts. When he heard Jesus speak those two words "follow me," Matthew must have felt the incredibly glorious and feather weight of grace. So much so that it lifted him to his feet in response, and he never looked back.

Matthew and Paul were really bad guys. Most likely, none of us have stooped down quite as low as either of them. Nevertheless, after having recently been walked through the Ten Commandments, we have all been reminded of our need for grace. Our need for forgiveness. And Christmas reminds us anew of that purpose in the arrival of Jesus, to save us from our sins. Aka, to lavish glorious grace upon us.

What has grace accomplished in you? What we notice in both of these New Testament examples is that grace transforms, it changes the people who receive it—who receive Jesus. Paul and Matthew, their lives changed. Even their occupations changed.

What has grace accomplished in you? This is where I could write out some things that changed in the lives of Paul and Matthew, and we could then compare *those* things with *our* things and see how we fare. I don't know about you, but I would probably feel inferior in that comparison. So, I won't list things that changed for them, I will simply end with the question and invite us to ponder, and answer it for ourselves. I will also invite you to listen in this coming Sunday, as we look deeper into how we answer—what has grace accomplished in me?






