MISSION SPOTLIGHT



World Refugee Day is June 20. It is an international day to honor refugees around the globe and celebrate the strength and courage of people who have been forced to flee their homes to escape conflict, persecution, natural disasters and other factors that threaten their lives, while also lamenting the circumstances that led to their forced displacement and harrowing journeys to find refuge. World Refugee Day is an opportunity to build empathy and understanding for the plight of displaced people and to recognize their resilience, to pray for displaced people and their homelands, and to take time to discern how God is calling us, as Christ followers, to provide compassionate care for those seeking refuge.



Service Spotlight. Opportunities to serve the YOUTH at Bethany.

Youth Board. The Youth Board is a committee that oversees the youth programs at Bethany. It is all things youth related! The board meets once a month before church on the 2nd Sunday of the month to discuss ideas and upcoming events for the youth. This committee is made up of 3 Consistory members and 3 members of the congregation, each serving a 3-year term. While these individuals serve on the committee, there are also many ways to tangibly support the youth of Bethany: driving and chaperoning for trips, mentoring our 10th & 11th grade students, leading small groups, making and helping serve meals on Wednesday nights, and helping supervise gym activities.

Sunday school & Wednesday Night Superintendents. The Superintendent is a 2-year term, for both Sunday & Wednesday programs. Invitations to serve are extended before the Annual Congregational Meeting each December. While these are two separate opportunities to serve, they are very similar in their duties. They both involve oversight of the daily operations of either the Sunday school or the Wednesday night activities, making sure things run smoothly, finding teachers, planning kickoffs and year end events, as well as coordinating with the Youth Pastor on calendars and cancellations.

Mentoring. At Bethany, students entering their 10th grade year begin a two-year mentoring relationship with a mentor of their choosing. The mentor is a caring adult who shares time, conversation and experience for the growth and encouragement of the student. Mentoring is the act of helping someone learn. Mentors can serve as a teacher, friend, guide and encourager. At the same, this relationship is intended to be mutually beneficial. Both the mentor and the mentee commit to participate for a specified period of time. Bethany arranges for a two-year commitment with a scheduled minimum of one meeting per month. Materials to help bring direction to the mentoring relationship are provided. Both the mentor and the mentee receive these materials in a three-ring binder.




SIOUX FALLS MISSION TRIP
