Are you listening to me?

A question like this usually carries with it a sense of urgency. Often it's a parent calling out to their child to respond to them, or a teacher trying to get through to a distracted student. Built into that call to listen is the expectation of a response, namely, obedience. In English, we have two words for this sequence of events, "listen," and "obey." In Hebrew, it's one word, "listen / hear" and "obey" are actually the same word: *shema*. I don't think there is any doubt about God's intent here. God calls out to his people to listen and obey, to do both of them. Deuteronomy 6:3 says, "Hear, Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you." In the New Testament, the same connection is taught by James in chapter 1, where he says:

²² Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. ²³ Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror ²⁴ and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.
 ²⁵ But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

James presents the connection between hearing and obeying so strongly that to fail here is equated with actually forgetting what you look like immediately after looking in a mirror. God minces no words is making His pronouncement on how we are to live in response to His Word. So, first, we have to read it. If we don't know what God says we will waver in our following. Psalm 119:105 says that God's Word is "a lamp to our feet and light to our path." May we read that Word, walk in it, and discover the joy, blessing and peace that is promised.




